

GENERAL GUIDE TO THE NRPS APPLICATION PROCESS

The NRPS comprises Commissioned Officers, Warrant Officers, Non Commissioned Officers and soldiers posted to units to assist with the training, administrative and special duties within the TA. Typical jobs are Permanent Staff Administration Officer and Regimental Administration Officer.

All posts are by appointment and are made by a selection board. NRPS personnel will typically have former service with the regular army. It is also possible for serving regulars to apply for appointments provided this is compatible with their retirement date.

The upper age limit for appointment is 55 years. Relaxation of this rule to meet special requirements may be authorised by the Ministry of Defence. The normal retiring age is on reaching the age of 60 years, but service beyond the age of 55 years is subject to satisfactory annual medical and efficiency reports and to the interests of the Service.

Rules and Regulations for NRPS are contained in TA Regulations 1978.

NRPS posts are managed by Regional Brigade Headquarters, and all applications should be sent direct to the relevant HQ as stated in the advert details on the R.A.O.L.
