Gunner Photographic Competition

The 2010 Gunner Photographic Competition is open to all regular Army and TA personnel, Ministry of Defence civilians and contractors who work directly for the Royal Artillery and dependants and partners of serving personnel.

Our judges will be looking for images that promote the Gunners, and which have good public relations potential.

If you've captured - or want to capture - a Gunner-related photograph of exceptional quality, this competition is the chance to showcase your work, the Royal regiment - and win a fantastic prize.

The deadline for entries is Friday 26 March 2010. The winners will be announced shortly afterwards and the prize giving ceremony will be held at Firepower in April 2010.

Rules

The 2010 Gunner Photographic Competition is open to all regular Army and TA personnel, Ministry of Defence civilians and contractors who work directly for the Royal Artillery and dependants and partners of serving personnel.

All photographs entered for the competition must have been taken between 1 January 2009 and 26 March 2010. Photographs taken before or after this date will not be accepted. Entries should reach: The Gunner, HQ DRA, RA Barracks, Larkhill, Salisbury, Wiltshire SP4 8QT by Friday 26 March 2010. Entries received after this will not be accepted.

The aim of this competition is to promote the Royal Artillery and the judges will be looking for images with PR potential, so please bear this in mind. Images must promote the Gunners, please be aware that inappropriate standards of dress, safety and conduct will not be considered.

The four categories are:

Regimental life

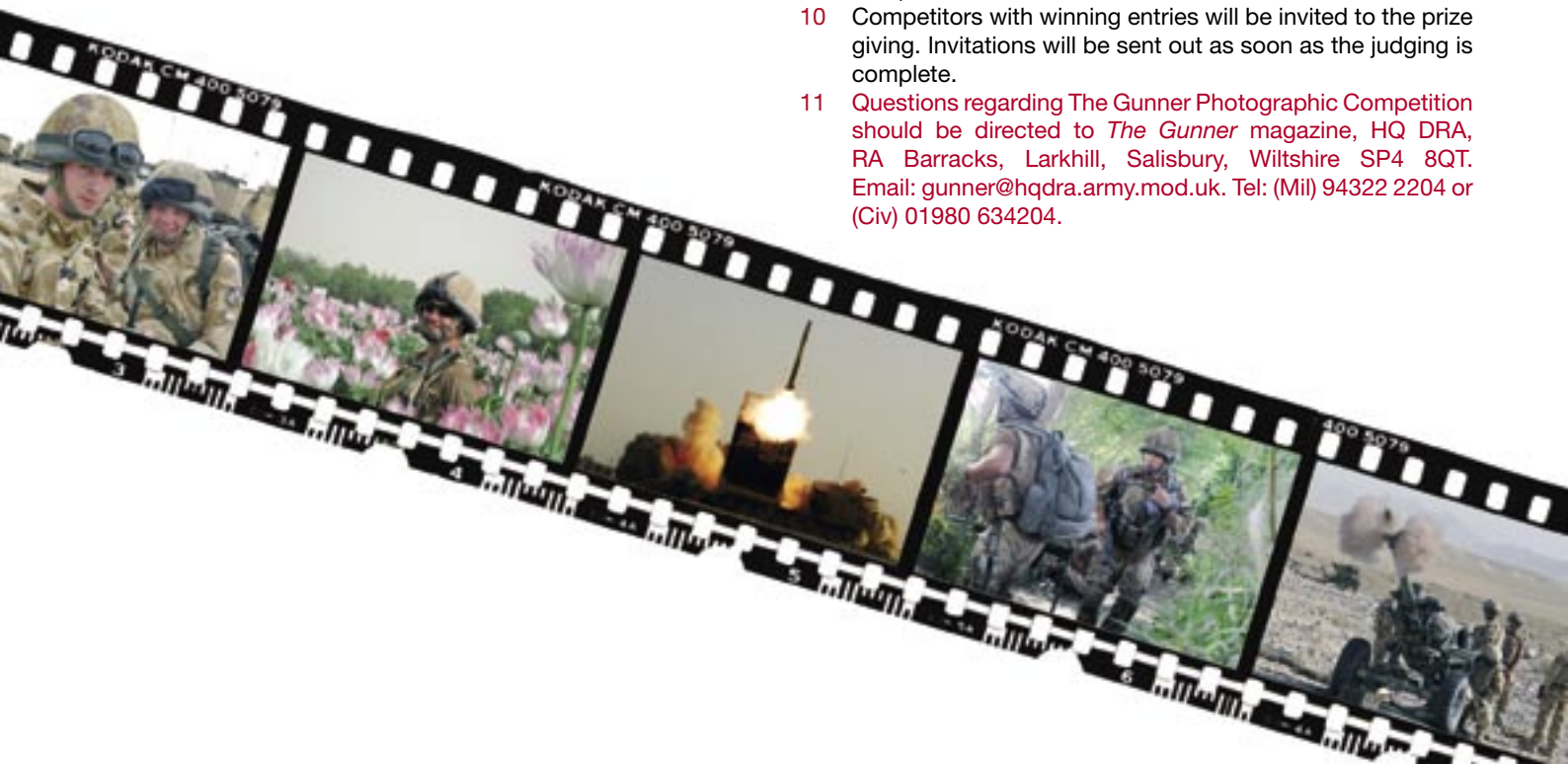
Operations

The regimental family

Sport and adventure training

Entrants must comply with the following requirements:

- 1 Entries can be prints or digital files
- 2 Each entry is to be between 10 and 12 inches on the longest side, and if a digital image should be at least 300dpi in resolution or higher. (*Entries that do meet these criteria will be disqualified*)
- 3 Digital images should be submitted on a CD and NOT by email. (*Entries that do meet these criteria will be disqualified*)
- 4 Negatives or transparencies should not be entered.
- 5 Each entry must be accompanied by a completed entry certificate (*Entries that do meet this criteria will be disqualified*)
- 6 Individuals may enter as many categories as they wish
- 7 All winning entries will go on public view. The civilian and military media may use copies of the entries. Images may also be selected for inclusion in official presentations and publications. *The Gunner* magazine shall be deemed to have the right to arrange for the publication and display of all images entered without payment or fee. If recognisable images of people appear in your entries you MUST have permission from them for the photograph containing their image to be published.
- 8 *The Gunner* magazine's decision will be final in all matters relating to the interpretation of the rules of the competition.
- 9 Every care will be taken of the submitted material; however, *The Gunner* magazine will not incur liability for any loss or damage, however caused. Photographs entered into the competition cannot be returned.
- 10 Competitors with winning entries will be invited to the prize giving. Invitations will be sent out as soon as the judging is complete.
