Works

As part of the Army Basing Programme works continue to improve the current traffic system within Tidworth.

Ordnance Road

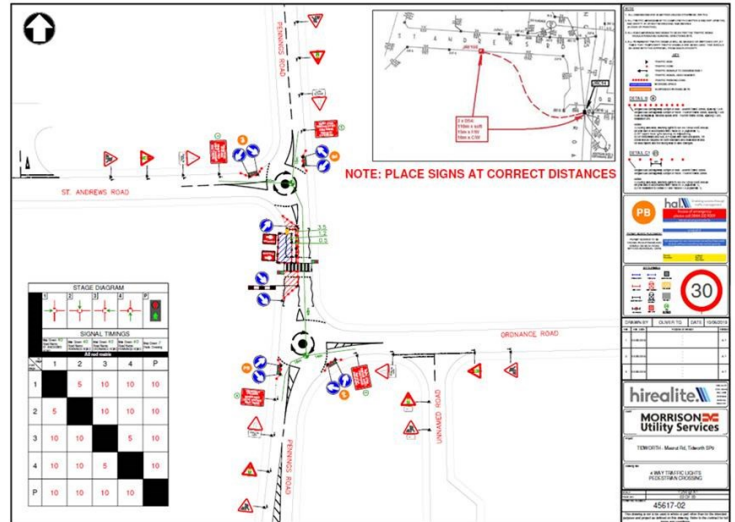
As part of the enabling works to construct the new roundabout adjacent to the ESSO petrol filling station on St Andrew's Road, BT are required to divert their underground cables that cross the A338 at the bottom of Ordnance Road.

Works are due to commence on Monday 15 July for a planned period of five days. Due to the imposed restricted working hours works may run into the following week. We will provide a timely update if these works are extended.



Traffic Management

The traffic during the BT diversion works will be controlled with a set of four way traffic lights with manual control between 0900 and 1530 Monday to Friday.



Outside of these hours and at weekends there will be no works carried out or traffic management in place.

Future Works

Virgin Media diversion works at Ordnance Road are currently planned to commence in late July for a potential period of around ten days.

The main works to improve the junction adjacent to the 'RAM' public house (Junction 22), which widen the junction and install a 'feeder lane', are currently planned (but are subject to change until a contract has been awarded and works are confirmed) to start in Sept 19 for a duration of approximately 14 weeks.
